<p>Numeracy /Mathematics</p>	<p>In maths and Numeracy this term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Counting forward and backward within 100. • Describing, continuing and identifying missing numbers within 50. • Ordering and comparing numbers within 50. • Matching numerical to the number word. • Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. • Adding and subtracting numbers within 20. • Doubling and halving numbers within 20. • Identifying and describing features of 2D shapes e.g. side, vertices etc... • Identifying 3D shapes. • Identifying 2D shapes within 3D shapes. • Creating tiling patterns incorporating at least 2 different shapes. • Creating symmetrical patterns and picture • Identifying the line of symmetry. • Using 50p, £1 and £2 coins. •

<p>Literacy</p>	<p>In literacy this term we will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beginning to use punctuation more consistently. • Continuing to sequence stories and develop our prediction skills. • Using connectives in sentences (and but etc...) • Continuing with word building. • Introducing constant blends (bl, cl, fl sl etc...) • Introduce vowel diagrams (oi/oy, ow/ou, ai/ay etc...) • Writing imaginative stories. • Writing personal texts. • Continuing to develop sentence structure. • Develop our letter formations and sizing of capital and lower case letters on the line. • Focus on letter formation in our full names. • Continuing to learn our common words. <p>In addition to this, we will still have our weekly reading book as well as having News Time/Circle Time to develop the children's talking and listening skills.</p> <p>The children will be able to take a weekly book home from our school library. We will go to the library on a Monday or Tuesday.</p>
